Eagle Process

Dustin Leo, District Advancement Chair, has completed the Eagle process documentation. There are 6 Eagle Coordinators covering specific areas of the district. The Eagle Coordinators will assign an Eagle Specialist to work with the Eagle Candidate from reviewing the application through the Eagle Board of Review. The Eagle process, and Coordinator names are on the website.

September is Leader Training Month

On September 8th, the Lost Dutchman District will be offering leader specific training for all Cub Scout and Boy Scout leaders. On October 6-7 (must attend both days), we will be offering the Outdoor Leadership Training for Boy Scout leaders and the Baloo Training for Cub Scout leaders. In addition, Council is offering the College of Commissioner Science on September 22nd for commissioners.

Finally, all leaders must have completed the new version of the Youth Protection Training by October 1, 2018. This is an on-line training course that will take anywhere from 1 to 1.5 hours to complete. Leaders will not be allowed to re-charter and will not be allowed to continue as a leader if they do not have the new YPT.

Your Unit Commissioner should have provided you with a current list of trained leaders and a list of leaders requiring training. Unit leaders need to be sure to get the word out to every leader that requires training.

If you can't make training in our district, you may also take on-line training at scouting.org, or check the Grand Canyon Council calendar for training in another district.

September is Recharter Month

Council Website For "JOINING" Scouts

A landing page has been created on the Grand Canyon Council website where the contact information for parents/families will be captured so we can follow up on their joining efforts.

Please visit https://www.grandcanyonbsa.org/join to see the map: More importantly, this landing page will populate a map of Arizona that will show every unit's "Join Scouting" night/open house. They will be able to click on your unit Pin and see what day, time and location your event will be held.

In order to make this work effectively, the unit COR or other Key 3 member needs to provide our District Executive Isaac Garcia with information pertaining to your "Join Scouting" event with location, time, day and point of contact. You can also include other details of your unit if you wish. If your unit has already had their "Join Scouting" event, please provide similar information but with the unit meeting information.

BeAScout PIN

This Pin is an important tool in recruiting new Scouts to your unit. It is a simple profile of your unit that provides the location and unit leader contact information for a parent/guardian seeking a unit for their potential Scout.

This also provides you with contact information for the person requesting the information. It is very important that you follow up in a timely manner as there is an "expiration" date built within the system.

Key 3 Leaders—please update your unit's beascout.org pin so that accurate information about the unit is posted.

There are also questions in the Organization Manager related to Family Scouting. If your Pack is welcoming girls in the Cub Scout program, it is very important to update that section of the Pin in order to reflect that the unit is a family program pack.

Here is how to make the updates related to Family Scouting but when you access the site, you can make other changes as needed:

1. Log in to your My.Scouting.org account

2. Select Menu at the top left

3. From the drop-down menu, select your unit

4. Select Organization Manager

5. Select the Settings tab

6. Scroll to Family Scouting

7. If the pack is remaining boy-only, do nothing (this is the default setting); otherwise, select "girls only" or "boys and girls"

8. Click Commit

Note: It may take up to 24 hours for the system to update to reflect the changes.
